Products: Rapid Set[®] TRU[®] Self-Leveling, TXP[™] Fast Epoxy Primer Amazon's corporate office at The Domain in North Austin just may be the coolest place to work in the Texas city, with eclectic furniture, colorful art, gathering spaces for employees and a fully stocked café. In 2017, the company turned its attention to the elevator landings of its multi-floor office space.

At each landing, contractor Texas Bomanite first applied TXP Epoxy Primer to the substrate to prevent pinholes and create a strong adhesive grip for the topping. Workers applied the primer by squeegee and then back-rolled to achieve a uniform thickness of 12 mils (0.3 mm).

Next, the crew mixed TRU Self-Leveling via Hippo mixers, placed it at 3/8-inch thick and finished with a spiked roller to release any trapped air and provide a smooth, level surface.

As a final decorative yet functional touch, the contractor stenciled the corresponding floor numbers on each landing, using adhesive-backed vinyl stencils and acetone stain.
