Tilt-up panels routinely require patching prior to painting because the construction method results in pinholes and other imperfections in the raised panels. Vee-Jay and subcontractor Salazar Brothers patched a new tilt-up structure located near downtown Kansas City, just north of the Missouri River in a region known to locals as Northland.

180,000 square feet of wall panels were completed with Mortar Mix used on the major repair work and WunderFixx used to patch the minor blemishes. Both products were mixed by hand and finished using trowels. The repaired areas blended well with the walls, and allowed for surfaces to be easily painted.
