After a 2014 bond passed, the Pflugerville Independent School District began construction on a new high school. It is the district's fourth high school in one of the top three suburban growth areas in the country. The 382,794 square foot building opened in the fall of 2017.

Extensive new flooring was installed as part of the interior work. To accommodate the flooring, American Constructors used Cement All to raise the concrete pads by ¼-inch. SET Control® was used to increase the working time allowing more time for placement and finishing. Products were mixed with a handheld mechanical mixer, broom finished, and water cured.

The new school accommodates 2,500 students on a 150-acre site, master planned for a future junior high and elementary school expansion.
