The Edgewater, New Jersey Whole Foods Market is more than just a grocery store. It overlooks Manhattan and is a popular lunch spot. Like many contemporary retail stores, Whole Foods favored a store design with an industrial aesthetic that is based on wide open spaces, clean lines, and simple eco-friendly materials.

Existing floors needed extensive work to make them level. They had to be shaved and ground as well as have deep patching. Products that were used to restore the floors and create a smooth surface included 425 bags of Cement All®, Concrete Mix, LevelFlor® and TRU® Self-Leveling. These were mixed in Hippo Mixers and finished with TRU Self-Leveling Spiked Rollers and a smoother. TXP Fast Epoxy Primer was used to prime the floors. The final surface was ground, colored and polished. Materials were supplied by White Cap.
